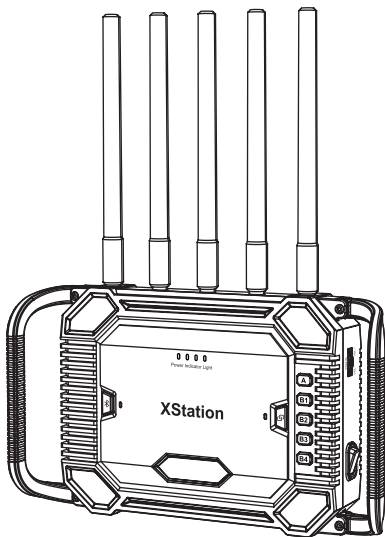

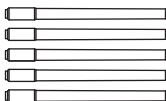
- Please keep the product in a dry, clean, dust-free environment.

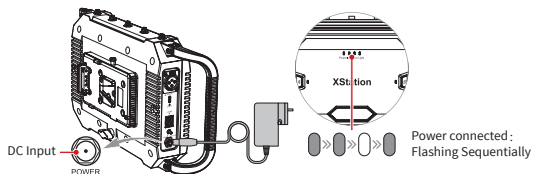
Operations

1. Installation

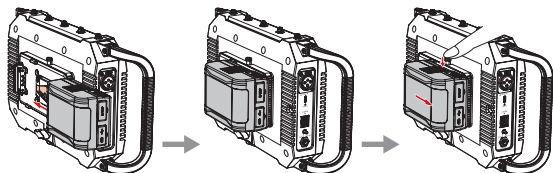
- (1). Install the Antennas.



(2). Connect to the DC power adapter or Install a V-Mount battery.

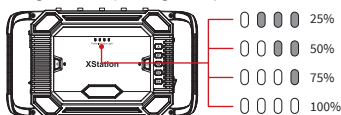


DC Power Adapter Connection



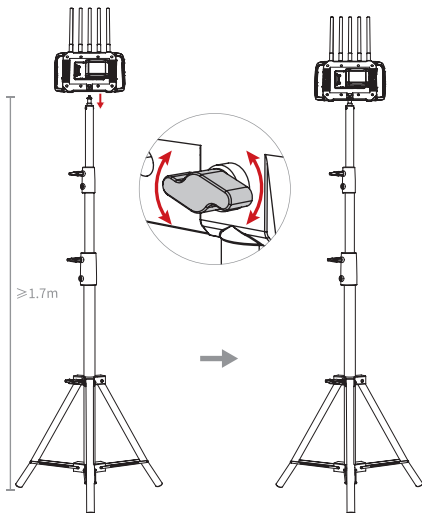
V-Mount Battery Installation/Removal

The four indicator lights represent 25%, 50%, 75% and 100%, with the number of lights indicating the corresponding battery level.



(3). Mount the XStation on a stand.

NOTE: Mount the XStation at a height of at least 1.7 m (5.6 ft) to minimize signal obstruction from the human body and other obstacles.



2. Power On/Off

Power on: Press " — ".

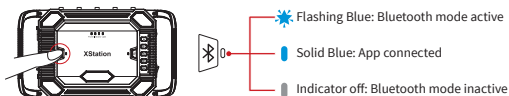
Power off: Press " o ".



3. Bluetooth Connection

(1). Long press the Bluetooth Pairing Button to enable Bluetooth mode.

4. Headset Pairing

*The XStation supports up to 20 SYNCO Master intercom headsets.

*Devices in the XM20 / XM20D + XStation kit are pre-paired and ready to use.

*Pair via the app or manually.

Manual Pairing - No Grouping Required

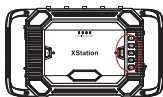
(1). Long press the Pairing Button on the XStation to enter the pairing mode (Indicator: Solid Red).

(2). Long press both the A and B buttons on the headset to enter pairing mode. Release after hearing "Pairing Successful". (Up to 20 headsets can be paired simultaneously).

(3). To complete the pairing process, long press the pairing button on the XStation to exit the pairing mode (Indicator off) after all headsets are paired.

*Intercom function is only active once the XStation exits pairing mode.

*After the XStation exits the pairing mode, the indicator on the headset's boom arm staying on (Green) signifies a successful connection.

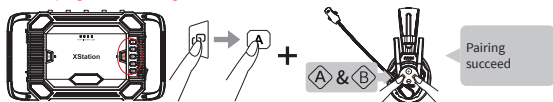

Manual Pairing - Grouping Required

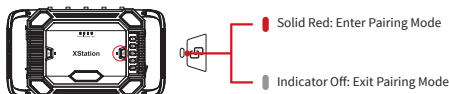
- (1). Long press the Pairing Button on the XStation to enter the pairing mode (Indicator: Solid Red), then short press the Group Button (A/B1/B2/B3/B4) to add the headset to the target group.
- (2). Long press both the A and B buttons on the headset to enter pairing mode. Release after hearing "Pairing Successful". (Up to 20 headsets can be paired simultaneously)
- (3). To complete the pairing process, long press the pairing button on the XStation to exit the pairing mode (Indicator off) after all headsets are paired.

***Intercom function is only active once the XStation exits pairing mode.**

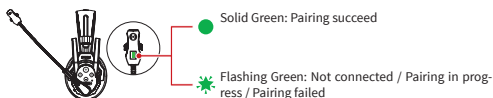

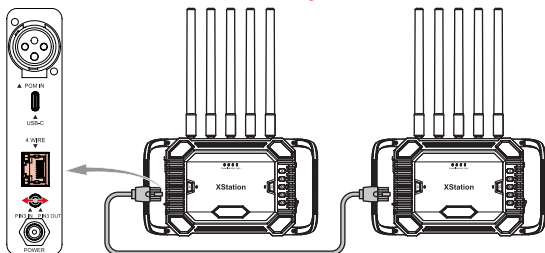
5. Group Assignment

Headset group assignment can only be set during pairing.

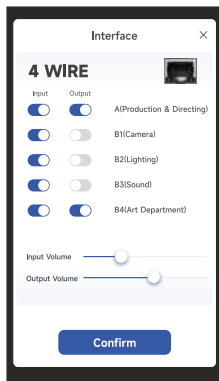
To change the group, use the SYNCO AUDIO App.

6. Dual-Base Station Cascade

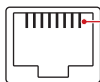
- * It supports cascading with a 4-wire device. Use the Pinout Selector Switch to match the pinout.
- * When cascading two XStations, the system supports up to 40 SYNCO Master intercom headsets.
- * Use the Cat5e Ethernet cable to connect.
- * Maximum recommended cascade cable length: 300m (984 ft).



- * You can select which group(s) send/receive the audio, and control the volume on the App.

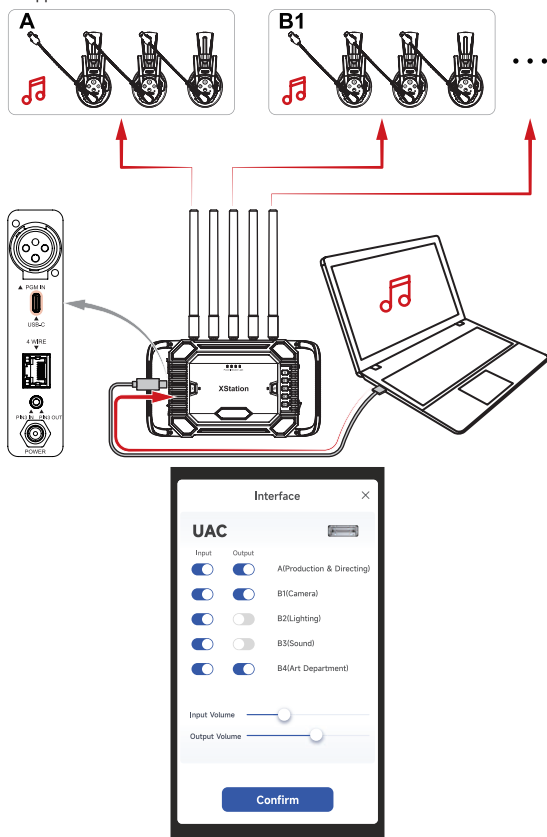

7. USB Audio (UAC) Connection

Connect the XStation to a computer using a USB-C data cable via the USB-C port. The audio played back on the computer will be shared with the paired headsets. (Drive: SYNCO XStation UAC Audio)

*You can select which group(s) send/receive the audio, and control the volume on the App.

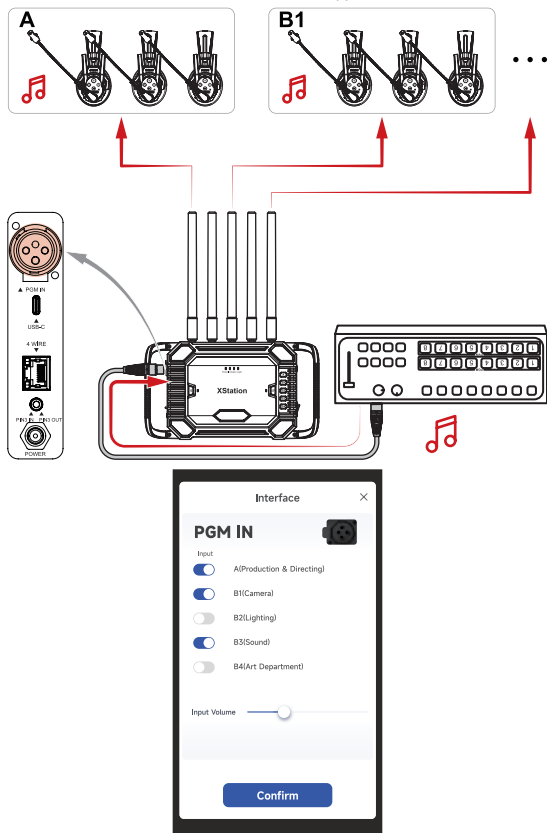


8. XLR Audio Input Connection

Connect the XStation to a production switcher or audio console via the PGM audio input using a standard XLR cable. The audio from the connected device is shared with the paired headsets.

*You can select which group(s) receive the audio on the App.

*You can control the volume via the wheel or the App.

Warranty Period

Thank you for purchasing SYNCO products.

1. Customers are entitled to free replacement or repair service in case of quality defect(s) found in the product under normal use within 30 days of receipt of the product.
2. Original SYNCO products are entitled to a 12-month limited warranty service.

3. Modifications to a product by its user or a third party without prior written consent of SYNCO, e.g. replacement of element or circuit, label alteration.
4. The code on the product is inconsistent with that of the warranty certificate, or

the code on the product or warranty certificate is altered or torn off.

5. All consumable accessories attached to a product, like cable, wind muff, battery
6. Faults as a result of force majeure, such as fire, flood, lightning, etc.
